LEAGUE INFORMATION

Dates: There are 7 weeks of matches beginning August 29th and concluding October 17th. There will be no games Labor Day weekend, 9/5/2020.

Times: All games will be played on Saturdays, ranging from 9:00 am – 2:00 pm. Practices are weekday evenings beginning the week of 8/3/20 & do not exceed two practices per week & after the first game, then reduce practices to 1 day a week.

Co-Ed: If there are not enough registrants in an age division, that division will be combined into a single co-ed division.

Location: Warren State Hospital grounds
(Intersection of: US Rt. 62 and PA 69)

Equipment: Shin guards are required. Soccer cleats are recommended, but optional (Must be soccer cleats = NO spike in front toe portion of shoe).

Code of Conduct and Discipline Policy

All Coaches, Parents, and Players agree to abide by the WCYRSL Code of Conduct upon registration and participation within the WCYRSL.

- I hereby pledge to abide by the **Warren County YMCA Recreational Soccer League Code of Conduct.**
- I will encourage good sportsmanship from players, coaches, officials & parents at every game & practice as well as I will demonstrate & role model good sportsmanship myself.
- I will not behave in a negative manner at games or practices & I will treat the players, coaches, officials and parents with respect & I will expect to be treated accordingly.
- I will do my best to provide & promote a safe & healthy playing environment for the players, coaches, officials & parents.
- I will remember that the game is for the players, not for adults. I will remember that participating in sports by playing, coaching or spectating is an opportunity to learn & have fun.
- I will provide & promote a sports environment that is free of drugs, tobacco, alcohol, & profanity & I will refrain from their use at all Warren County YMCA Recreational Soccer League events.

If there are any issues with a coach, volunteer or WCYRSL staff member, please make the time to see that individual personally before resorting to inappropriate means to express your dissatisfaction. If you cannot get your issue resolved, please take it up with a WCYRSL board member for resolution.

If anyone affiliated with, participating in, or attending an WCYRSL - sanctioned sporting event/activity violates the code of conduct &/or rules of the WCYRSL, the Board of Directors reserves the right to subject him/her to discipline or sanctions at the board's discretion. All suspensions and expulsions will be made at the WCYRSL Executive Board level.

Punishable conduct may be reported by anyone to a coach, a referee, or a League official and the authority for removal from the Fields will rest with the Executive Board of the League.

Violations the code of conduct &/or rules of the WCYRSL may result in, but are not limited to:

- Verbal &/or written warning
- Suspension & written documentation of incident kept on file
- Expulsion from the WCYRSL

Zero Tolerance Policy - towards gross unruliness is an immediate expulsion from the WCYRSL.

- Unacceptable behavior includes:
- Obscene or abusive language spoken loud enough for others to hear
- Whether directed at game officials, coaches, players or spectators.
- Abusive actions or language directed at referees.
- Fighting or threats of violence toward anyone.
- Unwillingness to abide by parking directions.
- Multiple warnings to abide to league rules
